THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Tourism in the year 2014-15 launched 'Swadesh Darshan' and 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' schemes for development of tourism infrastructure in the country including Jharkhand. The details of the projects sanctioned under the above schemes in Jharkhand are as under:

The Swadesh Darshan scheme of the Ministry has been revamped as 'Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0)' with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations.
