## VACANCIES IN ICAR

## 2586. Shri Ryaga Krishnaiah:

Will the Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare be pleased to state:
(a) whether Government is aware that many scientists and technical posts are lying vacant in Indian Council for Agricultural Research (ICAR);
(b) if so, the details thereof including information of sanctioned posts against the actual strength in various grade of scientists and technical posts;
(c) whether Government has taken steps to expedite the process of filling up of the vacant posts in ICAR; and
(d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

## ANSWER <br> THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a) and (b): Out of total sanctioned strength of 6586 positions in scientific cadre in Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) 1674 are vacant. Likewise, out of the total sanctioned strength of 6376 in case of technical cadre 2724 are vacant. Cadre and category wise details are as under:

(c) and (d) : The recruitment is a continuous process and the vacancies are filled up through an established procedure through the Agricultural Scientists Recruitment Board (ASRB) and other agencies as the case may be. The vacancy position is monitored regularly within ICAR and necessary steps have already been initiated to fill up the vacant posts expeditiously.
