CONTRACT FOR OPERATION OF RAILWAY STATIONS TO PRIVATE COMPANIES

- (a) the list of railway stations and name of the private companies to whom they have been given for the operations so far since 2018 and the number of stations Government intend to outsource in next five years;
- (b) the list of the stations and companies that have started the operations or are in the process to start;
- (c) the period for which each of these stations have been contracted out and details of the financial conditions, including revenue generation cum sharing model between company and Government; and
- (d) the eligibility criteria for such companies?
