(a) to (c) For infrastructure development at Tambaram Terminal, the development work has been taken up in two phases. Phase-I work for a value of ₹49 crore has been completed and Phase –II work for a value of ₹106 crore is being carried out and for which sufficient fund have been allocated.

The completion of any Railway project(s) depends on various factors like shifting of infringing utilities, statutory clearances from various authorities, geological and topographical conditions of area, law and order situation in the area of project(s) site, number of working months in a year for particular project site due to climatic conditions etc. All these factors affect the completion time of the project(s).
