(a) to (c): Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. In Bihar, the cities of Bhagalpur, Bihar Sharif, Muzaffarpur & Patna have been selected for development as Smart Cities. The year-wise and district-wise details of work done is not maintained. However, the status of projects and funds released for Smart Cities in Bihar are given below:
