**NO. 401. MS. SAROJ PANDEY:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of urban beneficiaries who have been provided houses under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), since the implementation of the scheme so far, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) the details of financial expenditure incurred so far by Government; and
- (c) the financial expenditure expected to be incurred till the completion of the scheme?

- (a) to (c): Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) 'Housing for All' Mission since June 25, 2015 to provide pucca house to all eligible urban beneficiaries. Under PMAY-U, a total of 118.90 lakh houses involving Central Assistance of ₹ 2.00 lakh crore (approximately) have been sanctioned; of which ₹ 1.47 lakh crore has been released so far. The implementation period of PMAY-U which was earlier upto 31.03.2022, has since been extended up to 31.12.2024, (except Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme vertical) to release the balance Central Assistance and complete all the houses sanctioned under the scheme without changing its funding pattern and implementation methodology. State-wise details of houses sanctioned and completed/delivered to the beneficiaries since inception of PMAY-U are at Annexure.
