CNG STATIONS IN THE STATE OF KARNATAKA

456 SHRI NARAYANA KORAGAPPA:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) as per Minimum Work Programme, whether Ministry has to establish 893 CNG stations in Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is a fact that 250 CNG stations have been established out of targeted 893 stations as on date;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the details of districts/cities where the 893 stations are proposed to be established and where 250 have so far been set up; and
- (f) the expected date by when target of 893 stations is going to be achieved?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS

(SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (f): Establishment of Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) stations is part of development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) network and the same is carried out by the entities authorised by the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB). After completion of 11A CGD bidding round, PNGRB has authorised 18 Geographical Areas (GAs) (including 1 GA spread over Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu & Karnataka and 1 GA spread over Telangana & Karnataka) covering the entire state of Karnataka for the development of CGD network. As per the Minimum Work Plan (MWP), the authorised entities have to establish 1,414 CNG stations in the state of Karnataka over the next 8-10 years. As on 31.05.2023, 312 CNG stations have been established. GA wise details of MWP target and achievement is at Annexure.
