**DOMESTIC LPG CONNECTION**

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of houses in the country without LPG connection; and
- (b) the subsidy Government has given for domestic LPG connection for the last five years; year-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) As on 01.07.2023, there are 31.50 crore domestic LPG consumers across the country covering 105.1% of estimated households based on census 2011. As census 2021 has not yet been conducted, updated number of households in the country are not available.

(b) The details of subsidy on LPG given by Government during each of the last five years are given below:
