NATIONAL INSTITUTES OF HOMOEOPATHY SYSTEM OF MEDICINE IN TAMIL NADU

484 DR. KANIMOZHI NVN SOMU:

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of National institutes of homoeopathy system of medicine in Tamil Nadu;
- (b) whether Government proposes to open new National institutes of Homoeopathy in Tamil Nadu and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the steps being taken to promote homoeopathy system of medicines in all the districts of Tamil Nadu; and
- (d) the details of the policies for publicity of the said system among the people?

ANSWER MINISTER OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) There is no National Institute of Homoeopathy system of medicine in Tamil Nadu.
- (b) There is no such proposal.
- (c)& (d) To promote Homoeopathy system of medicine in the districts of Tamil Nadu, the steps taken by the Ministry of Ayush are as under:
- i. Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy (CCRH), an apex research organisation under this Ministry has two research centers to promote Homoeopathy system of medicines in the districts of Tamil Nadu, namely:
 - 1. Homoeopathic Research Institute for Disabilities, Room No. 136, N.I.E.P.M.D Campus, ECR Road, Muttukadu, Chennai.
 - 2. Centre for Medicinal Plant Research in Homoeopathy, 3/126, Indira Nagar, Emerald Post, Ooty, Nilgiri District.
- ii. There are 14 Homoeopathic Medical Colleges with attached Hospitals imparting Homoeopathic education and promoting Homoeopathic system of medicine which are recognized by National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH), a Statutory Body under the Ministry of Ayush, of Govt. of India. (Annexure-I)
- iii. Ministry of Ayush is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM) through State/UT Governments including Tamil Nadu for overall

development and promotion of Ayush systems including Homoeopathy and providing financial assistance to them as per the proposals received in their State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) as per NAM guidelines. The mission inter-alia makes provision for the following: -

- 1) Operationalisation of Ayush Health & Wellness Centers including Homoeopathy by upgrading existing Ayush dispensaries and Health Sub-centers.
- 2) Co-location of Ayush facilities including Homoeopathy at Primary Health Centers (PHCs), community Health Centers (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs).
- 3) Upgradation of existing standalone Government Ayush Hospitals including Homoeopathy.
- 4) Upgradation of existing Government/ Panchayat/ Government aided Ayush Dispensaries/ Construction of building for existing Ayush Dispensary (Rented/dilapidated accommodation)/ Construction of building to establish new Ayush Dispensary including Homoeopathy.
- 5) Setting up of upto 10/30/50 bedded integrated Ayush Hospitals including Homoeopathy.
- 6) Supply of essential drugs to Government Ayush Hospitals, Government Dispensaries and Government/ Government aided Teaching Institutional Ayush Hospitals including Homoeopathy.
- 7) Establishment of new Ayush colleges including Homoeopathy in the States where availability of Ayush teaching institutions is inadequate in Government Sector.
- 8) Infrastructural development of Ayush Under-Graduate Institutions including Homoeopathy.
- 9) Infrastructural development of Ayush Post-Graduate Institutions including Homoeopathy/ add on PG/ Pharmacy/ Para-Medical Courses.

In this regard, State/UT Governments including Tamil Nadu may avail the eligible financial assistance by submitting the suitable proposals as per the NAM guidelines.

iv. The Ministry also implements the Central Sector Scheme for Promotion of Information Education and Communication (IEC) in Ayush to create awareness regarding Ayush Systems of Medicine. This aims to reach out to all sections of the population across the country including in the state of Tamil Nadu.
