## RAJYA SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.490 TO BE ANSWERED ON 25<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2023

### **AYUSH HOSPITALS**

#### 490 SHRI HARBHAJAN SINGH:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Ministry is aware of rising demand of ayurveda and naturopathy in the country;

(b) if so, whether the Ministry has taken any initiative to improve capacity of AYUSH hospitals in the country, including in the State of Punjab;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the budgetary provisions for AYUSH hospitals during the last three years and the current financial year and the actual expenditure during these years, year-wise?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) to (d) Yes Sir. Since, Public Health being a State subject, the primary responsibility to improve capacity of Ayush hospitals in the country including Punjab, comes under purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), there is provision of financial assistance to States/UTs for different activities including upgradation of existing standalone Government Ayush hospitals. Accordingly, the State/UT Governments may avail financial assistance by submitting suitable proposals through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs). Under NAM, as per the proposals received from State/UT Governments through SAAPs as per the provision of NAM guidelines, the State/UT-wise status of approved units for upgradation of existing standalone Government Ayush hospitals during last three years and current year is furnished at Annexure-I. Further, resource pool/budgetary provision is made for State/UT Governments including Punjab every year and State/UT Governments are required to submit their proposals through SAAPs as per their allocated resource pool for different activities including upgradation of existing standalone Government Ayush hospitals. As per proposals received from State/UT Governments through SAAPs, the status of grant-in-aid released for different activities including upgradation of existing standalone Government Ayush hospitals during the last three years and current year is furnished at Annexure-II.
