**AYURSWASTHYA YOJANA**

**491 SHRI ABIR RANJAN BISWAS:**

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) The total budget allocation and utilization of funds under AYURSWASTHYA YOJANA since the inception of the scheme, year-wise and State-wise.
- (b) The number of organizations that have benefitted financially from AYURSWASTHYA YOJANA since the inception of the scheme, year-wise and State-wise details; and
- (c) The number of AYUSH mobile clinics in remote and tribal areas across the country, State-wise?

**ANSWER  
THE MINISTER OF AYUSH  
(SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)**

- (a) Sir, the Ministry of Ayush is running a Central Sector Scheme, namely AYURSWASTHYA YOJANA and it has two components i.e. (i) AYUSH and Public Health (PHI) (ii) Centre of Excellence (CoE). The AYURSWASTHYA YOJANA was implemented in the Financial Year 2021-22. Under the scheme, funds are directly released to the eligible organizations/institutes based on the merit of the proposals, and not allocated directly to the States / UTs. The total budget allocation and utilization of funds under AYURSWASTHYA YOJANA since the inception of the scheme, year-wise is placed at **Annexure-I**.
- (b) The Scheme is implemented since the financial year 2021-22 and 24 (twenty four) number of institutes have benefited. The details of the fund allocated/dispensed to the organizations/institutes under the AYURSWASTHYA YOJANA since inception are placed at **Annexure-II**.
- (c) There is no specific provision for mobile clinics under AYURSWASTHYA YOJANA. However, some of the Research Councils, Autonomous Bodies and National Institutes of Ministry of Ayush are running mobile clinics. The details of such mobile clinics are placed at **Annexure-III**.
