Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of beneficiaries benefited from the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) during the last two years;
- (b) the name of the States having maximum number of beneficiaries;
- (c) the name of the States having minimum number of beneficiaries;
- (d) the total number of people benefited from the PMJAY in the State of Gujarat; and
- (e) the amount of total expenditure incurred by Government on this scheme during the last two years, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): A total number of 3.14 crore beneficiaries were benefited during the last two years under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY). The States/UTs having maximum and minimum number of beneficiary families supported by the Centre and State, are Uttar Pradesh and Lakshadweep, respectively.

In the State of Gujarat, AB-PMJAY is implemented in convergence with the State scheme Mukhyamantri Amrutum. As of 19th July 2023, a total of 41.34 lakh hospital admissions worth Rs. 8,564 crore have been authorized under the scheme in the State of Gujarat.

The details of central share of funds released during the last two years to States/UTs implementing the scheme are as under:
