- (a) the figures on diseases and economic burden of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) in the country during the last five years, State-wise and year-wise; and
- (b) the details of the funds allocated and actually spent on preventing and controlling NCDs during the last five years, year-wise and State-wise?

(a) and (b): As per Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) study report "India: Health of the Nation's States", the burden of Non-communicable Diseases (NCDs) like cancer, diabetes, cardiovascular diseases (CVDs) & stroke have increased in India from 1990 to 2016. The contribution of major NCDs to total deaths and total Disability-Adjusted Life Years (DALYs) is given in the table below:

The Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, provides technical and financial support to the States/UTs under the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Non-Communicable Diseases (NP-NCD) as part of National Health Mission (NHM), based on the proposals received from the States/UTs and subject to the resource envelope. The programme focusses on strengthening infrastructure, human resource development, health promotion & awareness generation for prevention, early diagnosis, management and referral to an appropriate level of healthcare facility for treatment of the Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs). For activities upto district level and below, States are given financial assistance under NHM in the ratio of 60:40 (90:10 in case of NE and hilly States). The State/UT wise Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) approvals towards NP-NCD under NHM during the FY 2018-19 to FY 2022-23 is given at Annexure 1. Under NP-NCD, 724 District NCD Clinics, 210 Cardiac Care Centre, 326 District Day Care Centres and 6110 Community Health Center NCD Clinics have been set up.
