### AIIMS IN KERALA

#### 603. DR. JOHN BRITTAS:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state: -

(a) whether it is a fact that the request of Kerala Government for according sanction to set up an All India Institute of Medical Science (AIIMS) in the State is pending with Government;

(b) whether it is also a fact that Kerala Government has already identified suitable land for setting up AIIMS at Kinalur in Kozhikode District and informed the Union Government;

(c) if so, the response of Government thereto; and

(d) whether AIIMS for Kerala will be announced in the current financial year?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (d) Under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), AIIMS are set up in different parts of the country in a phased manner, keeping in view the gaps in availability of tertiary health care facilities. Till date, 22 AIIMS have been sanctioned under the Scheme. Government of Kerala has identified & proposed four sites for the establishment of new AIIMS in the state: Kinaloor in Kozhikode district, Kattakada Taluk in Thiruvananthapuram district, Kottayam district and Ernakulam district. The proposal has not been approved in the current phase of PMSSY.

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
