FILLING UP OF TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING STAFF

665. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of posts of teaching and non teaching staffs advertised and filled up in various Central Universities since 1st January, 2023 till date, University-wise;
- (b) the details of number of posts which are targeted to be advertised and likely to be filled up upto 31st December, 2023, Central University-wise; and
- (c) the details of gap in sanctioned strength and in-position strength of teaching and non teaching staffs in Central Universities as on 20th July, 2023, University-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (c) Central Universities (CUs) under Ministry of Education are statutory autonomous organizations established under respective Central Acts of Parliament and governed by provisions of the Acts/Statutes/Ordinances made there under. Centralized record is not maintained regarding advertisement issued by the respective Central Universities. Occurring of vacancies and filling thereof is a continuous process. The vacancies arise due to retirement, resignation and additional requirements on account of enhanced students' strength. Through special recruitment drive 4305 teaching and 1782 non-teaching posts have been filled up till date by the Central Universities as per the DoPT Mission Recruitment Portal. Central universities have been given target to fill up 2151 teaching and 5368 non-teaching posts till 31st December 2023. Particular date wise information regarding sanctioned strength and existing strength is not maintained centrally.
