INDIANS STRANDED ABROAD

67. SHRI VIKRAMJIT SINGH SAHNEY

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether government is aware that there are thousands of stranded Indian men and women in various countries who have contacted respective Indian Embassies to come back to India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Ministry keeps data of such requests in various embassies for requests pertaining to sending them back to India; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, country-wise, month-wise, Indian domicile state-wise, including the State of Punjab?

ANSWER

- (a & b) A large number of Indians got stranded in the past due to COVID-19 pandemic and internal conflicts /wars. About 1.60 crore indians were repatriated to India by the Government through Vande Bharat Mission including air bubble agreements, 18,278 under 'Operation Ganga' from Ukraine, 669 from Afghanistan under 'Operation Devi Shakti' and 3961 Indians were evacuated from Sudan under 'Operation Kaveri'.
- (c & d) Data of requests from stranded Indian nationals for repatriation to India is maintained by respective Missions and Posts. Whenever a request is received, concerned Indian Mission/ Post takes prompt action for facilitation of repatriation of the stranded Indian nationals to India. Respective Missions and Posts provide all possible assistance like emergency medical care and boarding & lodging on means tested basis to the stranded Indians promptly. Government also bears the expenditure air tickets for repatriation of Indian nationals to India on means tested basis. State wise data including Punjab for repatriation of Indian nationals stranded abroad due to COVID-19 pandemic is given in attached Annexure I.
