**Establishment of new educational institutions**

Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a new university is established in India every week, a college every second day, an Atal Tinkering Lab every third day, and a new ITI every day, along with an IIT and IIM each year; and

(b) if so, State-wise and district-wise statistics and evidence for the last five years of all States and UTs?

(a) & (b) Considering the number of Universities and Colleges registered (cumulative) as per latest data of All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2020-21, vis-à-vis the number registered in AISHE 2015-16, on an average, 63 Universities and 945 Colleges are registered annually :-.

Since 2014, 7 new Indian Institutes of Management and 6 new Indian Institutes of Technology have been established.

Also, as per Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+), in all 26538 Atal Tinkering Labs have been established in school up to 2021-22.
