Student Enrolment and drop-out rate in the country

687 Shri B. Parthasaradhi Reddy:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) State-wise data on the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) of students at elementary, secondary, and senior secondary levels, including Telangana;
- (b) measures being taken by Government to achieve 100 per cent GER in the country;
- (c) State-wise data on the transition and dro'p-out rate of students at elementary, secondary, and senior secondary levels, including Telangana; and
- (d) measures being taken by Government to improve the transition rate and lower the drop-out rate of students in the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

(SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

- (a): The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education has developed the Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+) system to record data on indicators of school education provided by all the States and Union Territories. As per UDISE+ 2021-22, Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) of students at elementary, secondary and senior secondary levels State/UT-wise (including Telangana) is at Annexure-I.
- (b): Government of India launched Samagra Shiksha an Integrated Scheme for school education, w.e.f. 2018-19, as an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from preschool to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education to attain 100% GER.
- (c): As per UDISE+ 2021-22, the Transition Rate of students at elementary, secondary, and senior secondary levels and Drop-out Rate of students at Primary, Upper Primary and secondary levels State/UT-wise (including Telangana) is at Annexure-II.
- (d): The Samagra Shiksha scheme also focuses on identifying out of school children and their mainstreaming by providing financial assistance to the States and UTs for various activities to reduce dropouts at secondary level, which include opening/ strengthening of new schools up to senior secondary level, strengthening school infrastructure, setting up, up-gradation and running of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBV) upto class 12, setting up of residential schools/ hostels named Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalayas, transport allowance, undertaking enrolment drives, seasonal hostels/ residential camps, provision of vocational education and ICT facilities in schools, financial assistance for aids and appliances for children with special needs, etc.
