- (a) whether Government proposes to expand National Highways (NHs) in the State of Odisha;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the funds allocated for the purpose, NH-wise;
- (c) the present status of such ongoing expansion projects in the State along with the funds allocated for the purpose, NH-wise; and
- (d) the time-frame set for their completion, NH-wise?

(a) to (d) Expansion / development of National Highways (NHs) is a continuous process. National Highway projects are approved/sanctioned based on traffic demand, funds availability and inter se priority. The details of National Highway project in Odisha sanctioned/ awarded are at Annexure. Funds are allocated state wise for all NH developmental works in a state. Individual projects are completed as per the provisions in respective contract agreements.
