TWO LANING OF PATHANKOT-MANDI NATIONAL HIGHWAY

731. MS. INDU BALA GOSWAMI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a decision has been taken by Government to upgrade Pathankot-Mandi National Highway into a two-lane highway from Paraur to Mandi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the funds allotted by the Central Government for the said project?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) The status of Paraur to Mandi section having length of about 88 km is as under: -

- i. From Paraur to Padhar section, the work of preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) has been awarded.
- ii. From Padhar to Bijni section, the work of two-lane with paved shoulders has been awarded and the total approved capital cost of the project is Rs. 734.26 crore.
- iii. From Bijni to Mandi section, the work of four-laning with paved shoulder has been approved and in bidding stage. The total approved capital cost of the project is Rs. 1112.99 crore.
