**PMAY-G IN MAHARASHTRA**

754 DR. ANIL SUKHDEORAO BONDE:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of number of houses targeted to be constructed during the next three years under the Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana Gramin (PMAY-G) in Maharashtra State;
- (b) the names of the villages identified for construction of the said houses in Vidarbha region along with the stages in which the said work is likely to be carried out by Government; and
- (c) the details thereof?

(a) The Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) is being implemented with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2016 to provide assistance to eligible rural households with an overall target to construct 2.95 crore pucca houses with basic amenities by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024. Against the target of 2.95 crore houses, a total of 2.92 crore houses have been sanctioned to the beneficiaries by the States/Union Territories (UTs) and 2.41 crore houses have been completed as of 20.07.2023. At present, there is no proposal under consideration to start the next phase of PMAY-G beyond March 2024.
