**CAPTIVE EMPLOYER SCHEME**

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the launching date of the Captive Employer Scheme;
- (b) the details of people who got benefit from this scheme;
- (c) the total number of people to be benefitted from the said scheme; and
- (d) the places where the said scheme has been implemented?

**ANSWER**

(a): After completing all the processes of screening and selecting viable employers under the Captive Employment module of Deen Dayal Upadhyay Grameen Kaushal Yojna (DDU-GKY) programme, the Ministry entered into Memorandums of Understanding (MoU) with 19 captive employers on 28th March, 2023 for a period of three years.

(b) & (c): As per the MoU between the Ministry and 19 captive employers, the total targeted number of people to be benefitted from the scheme is 29,269 over a period of three years. However, no training has been commenced /completed as on date as the IT platform of implementing the programme is under construction.

(d): As per the MoU, the captive employment scheme under DDU-GKY is presently been implemented in 15 States and 1 Union Territory namely Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Haryana, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Puducherry.
