**ATTACKS ON INDIAN EMBASSIES**

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

- (a) the country-wise details of attacks on Indian Embassies situated abroad, till date;
- (b) whether the reasons for the attacks on the Indian Embassies have been identified by Government;
- (c) if so, the details of the action taken by the Government in response to these attacks; and
- (d) whether deficiencies have been found in the security provided by the Governments of respective countries to the Indian Embassies situated there, if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a to d) Anti-India and radical elements had organised demonstrations, attacks as well as arson at Missions/ Posts abroad. Recently, our Missions in London, Ottawa and Post in San Francisco have faced such acts. Such incidents were immediately taken up through diplomatic channels with authorities concerned of host countries for investigation, corrective action as well as for providing adequate safety and security. The host governments and its authorities are also called upon to undertake appropriate action as per their national laws and international obligations.

The authorities concerned in those countries had responded and Indian Missions / Posts abroad remain in constant engagement with the host governments to ensure safety and security of our personnel as well as of the Chancery premises.
