Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) overview of the Jan Shikshan Sansthan (Central Sector Scheme) scheme's implementation and its beneficiaries targeted in last five years, in Odisha;
- (b) steps taken by Government to ensure that the vocational skills and training provided through this scheme are relevant and aligned with local employment opportunities and market demands of Odisha;
- (c) how does government ensure the quality and standardization of the vocational training programmes offered by the NGOs under this scheme; and
- (d) steps taken to address any challenges or barriers faced in implementing the scheme in remote areas in Odisha?

ANSWER

(a) Under the Scheme of support to Jan Shikshan Sansthans (JSS) skill training is imparted to the Non-literates, Neo-literates, people having rudimentary level of education, School dropouts upto class 12th in the age group of 15-45.

At present 288 JSSs are functional in 28 states and 7 UTs across the country (including 28 JSSs in Odisha). The beneficiaries trained in the last five years under the scheme in the state of Odisha is given at **Annexure-1**. In total, 1,62,200 beneficiaries have been trained in the state of Odisha out of which 32994 beneficiaries are Male, 129124 beneficiaries are Female and 82 beneficiaries are Transgender.

(b) The Ministry has developed 15 NSQF (National Skills Qualification Framework) aligned courses relevant to the JSS beneficiaries. In addition to this, 35 NSQF courses have also been adopted for imparting training in JSSs.

The courses offered under the scheme are selected by JSSs based on local market demand and beneficiaries' need assessment through door-to-door surveys. Courses with maximum wage/self-employment opportunities are selected.

- (c) To maintain uniformity and skill standards, all the courses offered under the JSS Scheme are aligned to NSQF standards. Digital Literacy and employability skills are also incorporated in the course curriculum. Courses on local traditional skills are also promoted.
- (d) No barriers/challenges as such have been observed while implementing the scheme in the remote areas of the Odisha.
