DRUG ADDICTION AMONG CHILDREN IN THE COUNTRY

787 DR. V. SIVADASAN:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) number of children who are in prisons or juvenile homes or correction centres in the country, State-wise and year-wise data for the last five years;
- (b) number of children who have been booked under drug related offences, Statewise and year-wise data for the last five years;
- (c) number of reported cases of drug use among children, State-wise and year-wise data for the last five years; and
- (d) number of children who have been rehabilitated in shelter homes after drug abuse, State-wise and year-wise data for the last five years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a): State-wise and year-wise number of children who are in Child Care Institutions (Juvenile Homes) in the country under Mission Vatsalya Scheme (erstwhile Child Protection Services Scheme) for the last five years is at **Annexure-I**.
- (b): As per National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB), State-wise number of children who have been booked under drug related offences (the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985) for last five years (2017- 2021) are at **Annexure-II**.
- (c): As per National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR), State-wise details of complaints received in NCPCR regarding drug use among children in the country for the last five years (2018-2023) are at **Annexure-III**.
- (d): Ministry of Women and Child Development is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Mission Vatsalya' (erstwhile Child Protection Services Scheme), through the State/ UT Governments on cost sharing basis between the Central and the State Governments for delivering services for children in difficult circumstances, which include institutional care and non-institutional care services. The Child Care Institutions (CCIs) established under the Mission Vatsalya scheme support *inter-alia* age-appropriate education, access to vocational training, recreation, health care, counselling etc. Under Mission Vatsalya Scheme, Open Shelters registered by the State Government are

supported to look after children in need of care and protection including child substance abusers for the short term based on the need assessment of the district. These shelters are used for educating, counselling and imparting life skills to children in difficult circumstances, so as to keep them away from a life in the streets. State-wise and year-wise number of children who have been rehabilitated in Open Shelters including children involved in drug abuse under Mission Vatsalya Scheme during the last five years are at **Annexure-IV**.
