STATUS OF ONE-STOP CENTRES IN THE COUNTRY

799. SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:

Will the Minister of Women and Child Development be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of operational and closed One-Stop Centres in the country in last three years, year-wise, district-wise for Odisha;
- (b) the details of funds allocated and utilized under One-Stop Centre scheme in last three years, year-wise, district-wise for Odisha;
- (c) the number of psychologists/ counsellors available at these centres, district-wise for Odisha;
- (d) total number of women beneficiaries from this scheme in the last three years, district wise for Odisha?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT
(SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a): The Ministry of Women and Child Development has been implementing the One Stop Centre (OSC) scheme under Sambal component of Mission Shakti since 1st April, 2015. So far, a total of 801 OSCs have been approved in all 36 States/UTs. Out of these, 733 OSCs are currently functional. In Odisha, a total of 30 OSCs, one in each district, have been approved. All these 30 OSCs had been made operational by 2019-20. In other States/UTs, 50 OSCs were made operational in last 3 years (FY 2020-21- 5, FY 2021-22 – 20 and FY 2022-23 -25).

(b): The year-wise and district-wise details of funds allocated/released to and utilized by Odisha, in the last three years, are given in **Annexure**.

(c): The Ministry provides financial assistance to states / UTs for hiring of manpower for functioning of OSCs. However, the scheme does not envisage creation of regular posts. As such, the State/UT/District authorities are responsible for recruitment / hiring of suitable manpower / staff at these centres. There is a provision for hiring of 13 personnel for functioning of a One Stop Centre as per given details below:-

(d): More than 7.06 lakh women, including 21891 in Odisha, had been benefitted/ assisted by OSC's up to March, 2023 across the country.
