Air pollution in mining areas

836. SMT. MAHUA MAJI:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any plan to set up mobile stations in addition to the existing permanent monitoring stations across the country to measure air quality in view of the increasing air pollution from mining in mineral-rich States like Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the names of the States and the places where these mobile stations are proposed to be set up; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (c)

In order to monitor the continuous air quality of project sites in coal mining areas / washeries, a condition for installing the Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Stations (CAAQMS) is prescribed by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) in the Environment Clearance. Ambient air quality monitoring network of the country consists of 1429 stations (Manual + CAAQM Stations) at present, covering 511 cities in 28 States and 7 Union Territories (UTs). PM2.5 is monitored in 928 stations in 370 cities.

Further, Government has launched National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) in 2019 as a national level strategy to reduce air pollution levels across the country. Under NCAP, CPCB has identified 131 cities (including 123 non-attainment cities exceeding National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS), which were notified to protect human health) including Dhanbad, Ranchi and Jamshedpur cities of Jharkhand State and other states too. The List of 131 cities (NAC + 8 Million-plus cities) is enclosed at **Annexure – I**.

City Specific Clean Air Action Plans have been prepared and rolled out for implementation in these 131 non-attainment/million plus cities to improve the air quality. These plans target city specific air polluting sources like soil & road dust, vehicles, domestic fuel, MSW burning, construction material and industries with short-term priority action as well as those to be implemented in a medium to longer time frame along with the responsible agencies.
