# GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT RAJYA SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 896 TO BE ANSWERED ON 27.07.2023

### E-SHRAM PORTAL FOR UNORGANISED SECTOR

#### 896. SHRI VAIKO:

**SHRI M. SHANMUGAM:** 

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that more than 30 crore unorganized workers have been registered on e-Shram portal;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise, with a particular reference to the State of TamilNadu;
- (c) whether the accidental insurance coverage of ₹ 2 lakh to workers free of cost would be extended for three years;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether any special camps, drives or social media releases were organized to make awareness of the benefit of registering in e-Shram portal to the unorganized sector workers?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (e): Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India launched eShram portal (eshram.gov.in) on 26th August 2021 for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganised Workers verified with Aadhaar. eShram portal allows registration under 30 broad occupation sectors and around 400 occupations.

As on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2023, over 28.96 crore unorganised workers have registered on eShram portal. State-wise number of registrations on eShram portal including registration in the State of Tamil Nadu is at Annexure.

As of now there is no such proposal under consideration to extend accidental insurance coverage for 3 years.

Ministry has taken several steps for awareness and to expedite the registration of unorganised workers on eShram portal. Many registration camps and drives are being organised by Ministry from time to time in coordination with Common Service Centre (CSC). Social media platforms are also being used to spread awareness among workers to register on eShram. State Seva Kendra's (SSKs) and services of Common Service Centre's were on boarded to facilitate assisted mode registrations of unorganised workers. eShram is also on boarded on Unified Mobile Application for New-age Governance (UMANG app), to increase reach among the workers and provide registration/ update facility at the convenience of their mobile.
