- (a) the number of historical monuments in Maharashtra alongwith the district-wise details of the monuments which are being conserved by the Central Government and also funds allocated, spent for the maintenance and revenue earned from the said monuments during the last three years;
- (b) whether the State Government of Maharashtra has made any request for the conservation of other monuments and sites in the State and if so, the details thereof and the action taken in this regard; and
- (c) the number of security guards appointed at the said places location-wise along with the details thereof?
