- (a) whether Ministry is implementing Agriculture Marketing Scheme (AMS) in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the aims and objectives of the scheme;
- (c) the details of farmers benefited from the scheme during the last three years and the current year, year-wise and district-wise, in Andhra Pradesh;
- (d) whether it is a fact that no funds have been released for the scheme since 2019-20; and
- (e) if so, the reasons therefor and steps taken to release the same?

(a) to (e): Government of India is implementing a Central Sector Scheme of Integrated Scheme for Agricultural Marketing (ISAM) in the country including in the State of Andhra Pradesh, with an objective of providing farmers with access to competitive markets, facilitating online trading, grading & marking of agricultural commodities, creation and improvement of marketing infrastructure, creation of scientific storage capacity, capacity building and generating access to marketing information. ISAM has five sub-schemes viz. National Agriculture Market (e-NAM), Agricultural Marketing Infrastructure (AMI), Marketing Research and Information Network (MRIN), Strengthening of Agmark Grading Facilities (SAGF) & Chaudhary Charan Singh National Institute of Agricultural Marketing (CCS NIAM).

The details of e-NAM registered Farmers at Andhra Pradesh during the last three years and the current year, year-wise and district-wise in Andhra Pradesh is at Annexure-I. Details of no. of beneficiaries including farmers benefited from the AMI scheme during the last three years and the current year, year-wise and district-wise, in Andhra Pradesh is at Annexure-II. Further, the details of training programmes conducted by CCS NIAM during the last three years in the field of Agriculture Marketing in the State of Andhra Pradesh is at Annexure-III.

Since 2019-20 & upto 25.07.2023, Rs.1709.68 crore have been released under ISAM Scheme.
