NON-REVISION OF CGHS RATES FOR DBS IMPLANT AND BATTERY

100 SHRI AKHILESH PRASAD SINGH:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS) surgery for Parkinson's disease is also provided by CGHS empanelled hospitals;
- (b) if so, the details of number of DBS surgeries performed by CGHS empanelled hospitals during the last three years, year-wise and hospitals-wise;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that the CGHS rates for DBS implant and battery have not been revised since 2008 , and the beneficiaries are required to pay a huge difference of amounts; and
- (d) if so, whether Government proposes to revise the CGHS rate for DBS implant and battery?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO RAJYA SABHA
STARRED QUESTION NO. 100 * FOR 12TH DECEMBER, 2023**

(a) to (d) : Deep Brain Stimulation (DBS) surgery for Parkinson's diseases is a listed procedure under CGHS and treatment can be undertaken from CGHS empanelled hospitals. The details of permission granted for DBS Implant and Batteries are as under:

- i. In Delhi, permission for 01 DBS Implant was granted on 01.11.2023 for treatment at BLK-Max Hospital.
- ii. In Hyderabad, permission for 01 DBS Implant was granted on 15.06.2021 for treatment at NIMS, Hyderabad.
- iii. Permission for Battery Replacement was granted for 03 cases on 15.06.2021, 07.01.2022 and on 13.04.2022 for treatment at NIMS, Hyderabad.

The rates for DBS implants were notified vide OM No.

Misc/12014/2005/CGHS(R&H)/CGHS(P) dated 04.12.2008. These rates were further revalidated vide OM No. S.3849/09-CGHS(R&H)-CGHS(P) dated 08.12.2014 and OM No. Misc.12014/2005/CGHS(R&H) dated 09.07.2018. Further, Government has constituted a Committee to review and revise the ceiling rates for the various implants, admissible under CGHS, including DBS Implants and Battery.
