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**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. \*22 TO BE ANSWERED ON 05<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER, 2023 BY DR. SASMIT PATRA REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF STAND UP INDIA SCHEME**

(a) A total number of 72,807 loans have been sanctioned to borrowers of greenfield enterprises during the last three years under the Stand Up India Scheme. Year -wise and State/UT -wise data is as at Annexure-I.

(b) A total number of 2,260 loans have been sanctioned to borrowers of greenfield enterprises in the State of Odisha under the Scheme during the last three years. Year -wise and District-wise data is as at Annexure-II.

(c) Government of India provides budgetary support to Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) for advertising, publicity & creating awareness about the Stand Up India Scheme across the country.

Further, an online portal has been developed by SIDBI for the Stand Up India Scheme which provides support through more than 8000 active Hand Holding Agencies to prospective entrepreneurs in their endeavor to set up business enterprises, starting from training to filling up loan applications.
