STATEMENT

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY OF PARTS (a) & (b) OF THE RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *85 (10th POSITION) FOR ANSWER ON 11.12.2023 REGARDING SMART CITIES MISSION PROJECTS IN KARNATAKA.

(a) & (b) : Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. As per SCM Guidelines, Central Government will provide financial support to the extent of ₹ 48,000 crore over five years to the 100 Smart Cities i.e., on an average ₹ 100 crore per city per year. An equal amount on a matching basis will be contributed by the State Government/Urban Local Body (ULB) except in North-East and Hilly States where this matching contribution is expected to be 10 percent.

As on 27 November 2023, work orders have been issued in 7,959 projects worth around ₹ 1,71,224 crore; of which 6,271 projects worth ₹ 1,16,269 crore have been completed. ₹ 78,749.88 crore has been released; of which ₹ 71,135.70 crore (90%) has been utilized.

In the State of Karnataka, 7 cities i.e., Bengaluru, Belagavi, Davanagere, Hubballi-Dharwad, Mangaluru, Shivamogga and Tumakuru were selected for development as Smart Cities. The status of projects in these cities is given below:
