Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any survey/ estimation has been done by Government for the assessment of floating population in major cities of the country, if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the expenditure incurred by Government in upgrading public infrastructure in the aspirational districts in the State of Madhya Pradesh and the details thereof?

(a) & (b): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement referred in reply to Rajya Sabha Starred Q. NO. 90 for 11.12.2023 regarding “Estimation of Floating Population in Cities”

- (a) No, Sir. Estimates of the floating population in the country are not available. As per 2011 Census, migrants from rural to urban areas were about 79 million.
- (b) Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, through its various missions and Programmes viz., Swachh Bharat Mission– Urban, Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation and Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban, supplements the efforts of the State Governments (including Madhya Pradesh) towards creating and upgrading public infrastructure in the States/UTs including in the aspirational districts.(Details at Annexure I)

1. Swachh Bharat Mission – Urban (SBM-U)

Swachh Bharat Mission – Urban (SBM-U) is being implemented in the Urban Local Bodies to strengthen the sanitation infrastructure.
