VARIATIONS OF EXPENDITURE ON HEALTH CARE

1060. DR. SONAL MANSINGH:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the significant variations among states in terms of expenditure on health care;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) the details of the States which are on top in terms of per capita health expenditure; and
- (d) the details of the States in which the per capita expenditure on health is relatively low?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. S. P. SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) to (d): According to the National Health Accounts estimates (NHA) for India, 2019-20, the State Total Health Expenditure (STHE) available for 21 States ranges from Rs. 4,042 crore for the State of Jammu and Kashmir to Rs. 84,841 crore for the State of Uttar Pradesh.

In terms of Per Capita STHE, the range is Rs. 1,588 in Bihar to Rs. 10,607 in Kerala with National estimate being Rs. 4,863. The State-wise STHE and Per Capita STHE is as under:
