STATE-WISE TOTAL MBBS SEATS

1063. SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR MODI:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the total MBBS seats, projected population of States, total MBBS seats allowed, the percentage of seats more than allowed by National Medical Commission (NMC), State-wise;
- (b) whether it is a fact that NMC has put on hold on new medical colleges and expansion of existing colleges in the States with more than 100 medical education seats per million population, the reason therefor;
- (c) whether it will not affect the southern and western States and encroach on States' rights; and
- (d) the details of Government effort to resolve this imbalance?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (d): The Government has increased number of medical colleges and subsequently increased MBBS seats. There is an increase of 82% in medical colleges from 387 before 2014 to 706 as of now. Further, there is an increase of 112% in MBBS seats from 51,348 before 2014 to 1,08,940 as of now, there is also an increase of 127% in PG seats from 31,185 before 2014 to 70,674 as of now. The State/UT-wise list of MBBS seats in the country for the AY 2023-24 is attached at Annexure.

The "Guidelines for Under Graduate Courses under Establishment of New Medical Institutions, Starting of New Medical Courses, Increase of Seats for Existing Courses & Assessment and Rating Regulations, 2023" issued by the National Medical Commission (NMC) on 16th August, 2023, have provision of the ratio of 100 MBBS seats for 10 lakh population in the State/UT. However, NMC, vide Public Notice dated 15th November, 2023, has declared that Chapter-1 of these Guidelines, which includes this provision, has been put on hold.
