PM SHRI School Yojana

1135 Shri Vivek K. Tankha:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of funds disbursed under PM SHRI School Yojana since 2022, State-wise and year-wise details thereof;
- (b) whether any new school has been established under the said program, if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) in which spheres Government intend to allocate funds to improve quality of education, details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) The cabinet has approved a Centrally Sponsored Scheme named Pradhan Mantri Schools for Rising India (PM SHRI) on 7th September, 2022. These schools are to showcase the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020 and emerge as exemplar schools over a period of time, and also offer leadership to other schools in the neighbourhood. A Central share of Rs. 630.11 crore has been released as 1st installment for FY 2023-24 to States/UTs/KVS/NVS for implementation of the scheme. The State/UT/KVS/NVS wise details of the funds released is attached at **Annexure-I**.

(b) As per the Cabinet Note, PM SHRI Scheme seeks to set up more than 14,500 schools by strengthening the existing schools from amongst schools managed by Central government/State/UT Government/local bodies/KVs/NVs.

(c) The government intends to allocate funds for diverse education improvement initiatives as mandated by the NEP 2020. These include promoting green practices, enhancing digital infrastructure (ICT), providing annual grants based on student numbers, supporting pre-primary schools, holistic report cards, teacher resources, and vocational education. Additionally, there are provisions for libraries, sports facilities, innovative projects, community involvement, teacher training, and special needs support. The comprehensive strategy aims to improve educational quality across Curriculum, Pedagogy and Assessments, Access and Infrastructure, Human Resources and School Leadership, Inclusive Practices and Gender Equity, Management, Monitoring and Governance and Beneficiary Satisfaction.
