- (a) whether Government is planning to increase the number of Junior Research Fellowship in various subjects in future;
- (b) the details of Number of students appeared in UGC NET examination, State-wise and Subject-wise separately in the last four years;
- (c) the number of students who have qualified NET/JRF, State-wise and subject-wise separately in the last four years; and
- (d) the number of Examination centres set up for UGC-NET examination, District-wise in each State?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (Dr. SUBHAS SARKAR)

- (a): As reported by the University Grants Commission (UGC), presently there is no such proposal to increase the number of Junior Research Fellowship (JRF).
- (b) & (c): The National Testing Agency has been conducting UGC-NET since December 2018, in Computer Based Test (CBT), mode twice a year to determine the eligibility of Indian Nationals for 'Assistant Professor' and 'Junior Research Fellowship & Assistant Professor' in Indian Universities and Colleges.
