TRAFFIC CONGESTION ON SALEM-KOCHI HIGHWAY

- (a) whether Government is aware of the severe traffic conditions on the Salem-Kochi Highway (NH 544) connecting Salem city in Tamil Nadu to the city of Kochi in Kerala;
- (b) the steps taken to tackle the issue of heavy road traffic on this highway creating problems to daily domestic passengers and commercial vehicles; and
- (c) whether Government has any plan to convert it to 6 lanes, and if so, the details thereof?
