**AZADI SE ANTYODAYA TAK CAMPAIGN**

1222 DR. AMAR PATNAIK:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has data related to the budgetary allocation and expenditure incurred under the Azadi Se Antyodaya Tak Campaign till 31st October 2023;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise and if not, reasons therefor;
- (c) the data related to the number of districts selected in every State for the campaign, the criteria and reason for selecting different numbers of districts in different States; and
- (d) the details of benefits the campaign is expected to reach to benefit the citizens in the selected districts?

**ANSWER**

(SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): No separate budgetary allocation was made for the 'Azadi se Antyodaya Tak' campaign.

(b): Does not arise.

(c): 75 Districts, marginally lagging behind in development parameters, were shortlisted for the campaign across various States/UTs by using MPCE (Monthly Per Capita Consumption Expenditure) and D5/D7 SECC-2011 (Socio Economic Caste Census) data. The identified districts were aligned with the birth place of Freedom Fighters. The details of Districts is provided in **Annexure I**.

(d): The goal of the campaign was to take up 17 select schemes with direct assistance to beneficiaries in saturation mode, reaching out to the person at the bottom of the pyramid in rural areas by each of the participating Ministries/Departments viz. Ministry of Rural Development, Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Ministry of Women & Child Development, Department of Financial Services, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Department of Agriculture & farmers Welfare, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying and Ministry of Labour & Employment. Ministry-wise breakup of schemes and their respective KPIs is provided in **Annexure II**.
