- (a) the number of days of work given to unskilled labour under MGNREGS in Andhra Pradesh during the last five years, year-wise;
- (b) the details of women participation in MGNREGS in the last five years, year-wise and district-wise;
- (c) whether it is a fact that participation of women has not crossed even 40% in spite of Government's efforts; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor and the efforts being made by the Government to encourage women participation in MGNREGS in AP?

(a): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment Scheme. Details of persondays generated in the State of Andhra Pradesh under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS from financial years 2018-19 to 2022-23 are given below:
