ANGANWADI CENTRES UNDER POSHAN ABHIYAAN

1266. SHRI. DHANANJAY BHIMRAO MAHADIK:

Will the Minister of Women & Child Development be pleased to state:

- (a) The details of process of registration of beneficiaries under the Poshan Abhiyaan;
- (b) Whether Government has been able to achieve the objectives of POSHAN Abhiyaan in Maharashtra and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefore;
- (c) The details of funds released to the State of Maharashtra during last three years under POSHAN Abhiyaan and Mission Shakti Scheme;
- (d) The number of Anganwadi centres in Maharashtra wherein POSHAN Abhiyaan scheme is being implemented, district-wise; and
- (e) Whether Government has conducted any study on the results of this scheme in Maharashtra and if so, the details and the outcome thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0 (Mission Poshan 2.0) is an (a) integrated nutrition support programme, to strengthen nutritional content, delivery, outreach and outcomes with focus on developing practices that nurture health. wellness and immunity to disease and malnutrition. Mission Poshan 2.0 is a universal self-selecting scheme available to all the beneficiaries who enrol at the AWCs. The beneficiaries under this scheme are children in the age group of 0-6 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers and Adolescent Girls between 14-18 years (North Eastern States and Aspirational Districts). In order to avail the services under the scheme the beneficiary needs to be enrolled at the Anganwadi Centre by the Anganwadi Worker which is now being done on Poshan Tracker application. As on date approximately, 10.23 crore beneficiaries have been registered under the scheme and approximately 95% have been Aadhar verified. In order to avail the services under Mission Poshan 2.0, Aadhar registration is mandatory. However, if a child's Aadhar card is not available, then the benefits under the scheme can be accessed using the mother's/father's/guardian's Aadhaar card.

- (b) to (d) Under Poshan 2.0, supplementary nutrition is provided to beneficiaries enrolled at the Anganwadi Centres for 300 days in a year. Multiple coordinated efforts have been taken to improve nutritional outcomes among the beneficiaries in Maharashtra, the details are as under:
 - i. The data from Poshan Tracker for November 2023 shows 1,10,515 operational Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) and 71,94,571 registered beneficiaries which includes Pregnant Women, Lactating Mothers, Children under 6 years. In addition, 1,19,365 Adolescent Girls (14-18 years in Aspirational districts) are also enrolled as beneficiaries. Moreover, 95.48% beneficiaries are Aadhar verified.
 - ii. 1,10,486 Smartphones and 1,10,486 Growth Monitoring Devices are available in Maharashtra.
 - iii. 1150 Anganwadi Centres were approved for upgradation to Saksham Anganwadis in the FY 2022-23.
 - iv. Under Mission Poshan 2.0, 'Poshan Maah' is celebrated each year in the month of September and 'Poshan Pakhwada' is celebrated in the month of March with the aim to create awareness about nutrition and healthy food. Through these *Jan Andolans*, large scale and continuous behaviour change interventions are being carried out. Over 15 crore activities have been undertaken in the State since September 2018.

The details of the fund released to the State of Maharashtra under Mission Poshan 2.0 and Mission Shakti during the last three years is at **Annexure I.**

Mission Poshan 2.0 is being implemented in all the 36 districts of the State covering 1,10,515 Anganwadi Centres. The district-wise details of the number of Anganwadi Centres in the state of Maharashtra is at **Annexure-II.**

(e) A third party evaluation of all Centrally Sponsored Schemes in Women and Child Development Sector including Anganwadi services, POSHAN Abhiyaan was conducted by NITI Aayog in 2020. The evaluation found the relevance of Anganwadi Services scheme & POSHAN Abhiyaan satisfactory.
