MEASURES TAKEN TO HELP HIV AFFECTED WOMEN PATIENT

1274. SMT. SANGEETA YADAV:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the measures taken by Government to provide care, support and treatment to HIV affected women patients and children thereof, especially in nutrition, education, social protection;
- (b) whether Government has any budgetary provision/ scheme for welfare of HIVaffected women and children;
- (c) if so, the amount spent on welfare of HIV affected women patients in last three years, year-wise and State-wise;
- (d) the efforts made by Government for reducing the incidence and prevalence of HIV and AIDS among women enhancing their quality of life; and
- (e) the future plans of Government to address the needs and concerns of HIV affected women?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (e): Government of India has taken various steps under the National AIDS and STD Control Programme (NACP) to provide free life-long, high quality antiretroviral (ARV) medicines to all the people living with HIV (including women and Children) from treatment facilities across the country.

Under the mainstreaming efforts of NACP, various social protection benefits in terms of nutrition, education and social protection are provided to the people living with HIV including women and children infected and affected by HIV by the State

Governments / Union Territory Administrations (UTs). To ensure the access to quality health care and well-being of these populations, State AIDS Control Societies (SACS) continuously advocate with the line departments in the States/ UTs for extending exclusive and inclusive social protection benefits from the States/ UTs. The State/ UT - wise list of schemes is at **Annexure**. The amount spent for Supply & Material under NACP in FY 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 are ₹1450.18 Crores, ₹591.58 Crores and ₹ 619.21 Crores respectively.
