(a) to (b) India and the UK are negotiating a Free Trade Agreement (FTA) since 13th January 2022. 12 rounds of negotiations have been held so far and 13th round of negotiations began on 18th September 2023. The negotiations have progressed well and both sides are rigorously engaged to work out a trade deal that is fair, equitable and mutually beneficial, which takes into consideration the ambitions and sensitivities of both the sides.
