PROGRESS OF PM GATI SHAKTI MASTERPLAN

1475. Smt. Sangeeta Yadav:

Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Integrated Project monitoring portal has been set up under the Prime Minister Gati Shakti National Masterplan (NMP);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of data layers uploaded on NMP till date;
- (d) whether critical infrastructure gaps pertaining to different sectors have been identified; and
- (e) if so, the details of the success achieved in addressing these loopholes in the last two years, years-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI SOM PARKASH)

(a) to (c): The Project Monitoring Group (PMG) is a mechanism set up to monitor implementation of the projects valued at Rs. 500 crore and above with specifically defined milestones on the PMG portal. Projects are monitored for their physical and financial progress. This mechanism also facilitates resolution of various issues, including land acquisition pertaining to the projects of Central Government and some of the important private projects under implementation.

For planning of multimodal infrastructure connectivity projects, PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan was launched in Oct 2021. Till now, more than <u>1463 GIS data</u> layers pertaining to infrastructure assets (economic and social), geographical features, demographic data etc have been mapped on PMGS-NMP

(d) & (e): Hundred(100) infrastructure connectivity gaps have been identified using PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan and its institutional setup, to improve connectivity to various Ports and for movement of bulk commodities such as Food & Fertiliser, Steel, Coal sectors etc. Accordingly, a provision of Rs. 75,000 crores has been made for undertaking these 100 rail and road projects in the Union Budget of FY 2023-24.
