Funds allocation for PMMSY

1537. Shri Pabitra Margherita:

Will the Minister of **Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated for Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) for ecologically healthy and socially inclusive development of the fisheries sector in the country; and;
- (b) the details of fish productivity per hectare in the country?

ANSWER

(a) and (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing a flagship scheme namely Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) with an investment of ₹20050 crore in all the States and Union Territories (UTs) for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21 to FY 2024-25 for holistic development of the fisheries sector in the country. During the last three financial years (FY 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23), and current financial year (2023-24) projects worth of Rs. 17527.23 crore with a central share of Rs. 7209.32 crore have been approved for various State Governments/Union Territories and other implementing agencies under PMMSY for development of fisheries and aquaculture sector. The Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana being implemented inter-alia envisages enhancing the productivity from 3 tonnes/hectare to 5 tonnes/hectare in the country by 2024-25.
