1573 SHRI PARIMAL NATHWANI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of outlets under 'One Station One Product (OSOP)' scheme being opened in Railway Stations in the country;
- (b) the number of beneficiaries enlisted in the scheme and the details of benefits availed by beneficiaries; and
- (c) the details of such stations covered under OSOP in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat and Jharkhand, with the number of beneficiaries in each of the States, respectively?

(a): As on 30.11.2023, a total of 1189 One Station One Product (OSOP) outlets are operational at 1083 stations across Indian Railways.

(b): A total of 41,280 direct beneficiaries have availed the opportunities being offered under the OSOP scheme so far. Under this scheme, the applicant is offered an outlet at stations for selling and showcasing their products.

(c): Details of stations, outlets and direct beneficiaries covered under OSOP scheme in the states of Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat and Jharkhand (as on 30.11.2023) are as under:
