SAMARTH SCHEME IN ODISHA

1598. DR. SASMIT PATRA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of beneficiaries trained and placed under the SAMARTH scheme in the last three years, State-wise and district-wise, for the State of Odisha;
- (b) the number of training centers operating under the scheme, State-wise and district-wise, for the State of Odisha; and
- (c) the funds allocated and utilized under the scheme in the last three years, State-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR TEXTILES
(SMT. DARSHANA JARDOSH)

(a): Ministry of Textiles is implementing (Samarth)- Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector (SCBTS) with the objective to provide demand driven, placement oriented National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) compliant skilling programme to incentivize and supplement the efforts of the industry in creating jobs in the organized textile (excluding Spinning and Weaving) and related sectors. The scheme also provides skilling and skill upgradation courses to weavers/ artisan in the traditional sectors such as Handlooms, Handicrafts, Silk and Jute. Samarth is implemented on demand driven basis across the country. Under this scheme preference is given to marginalized social groups such as women, SC/ST etc. Majority of beneficiaries under the scheme are women.

The details of beneficiaries trained and placed under Samarth scheme during last three years, State/UT-wise including Odisha are given at **Annexure-I** and district-wise in State of Odisha at **Annexure-II**.

(b): The details of operating training centers under the Samarth scheme during last three years, state/UT-wise including Odisha are given at **Annexure-III** and district-wise in State of Odisha at **Annexure-IV**.

(c): Samarth is implemented on demand driven basis across the country. There is no State-wise allocation of funds under Samarth. The cost of training programme under the scheme is released directly to Implementing Partners. An amount of Rs. 199.66 crore has been utilized under Samarth across the country including the State of Odisha during last three years.
