UDAN SCHEME IN THE STATE OF BIHAR

- (a) whether a new airport is proposed to be constructed in Bihar under the UDAN scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the work accomplished till date for the proposed airport the details thereof?

(a) to (c): UDAN is a demand driven scheme where bidding rounds are conducted from time to time to cover more destinations/stations and routes. Based on their assessment of demand on particular routes, interested airlines submit their proposals at the time of bidding under UDAN. An airport which is included in the awarded routes of UDAN and requires upgradation/development for commencement of UDAN operations, is developed under the 'Revival of unserved and underserved airports' scheme.

The following unserved airports in Bihar are available in the UDAN document. Arrah, Begusarai, Bettiah, Bhabua (Kaimoor), Bhagalpur, Bihar Sharif, Bihta, Birpur, Buxar, Chhapra, Dehri On Sone, Forbesganj, Hathwa, Jehanabad, Jogbani, Katihar, Kishangani, Madhubani, Motihari, Munger, Muzzafarpur, Panchanpur, Purnea, Raxaul, Saharsa, Sabeya (Gopalganj) & Valmiki Nagar.
