**Beneficiaries under PMUY in the State of Rajasthan**

1722# Shri Ghanshyam Tiwari:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) in the context of Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (b) whether it is a fact that subsidies are being provided by Government for domestic gas connections under the Ujjwala Yojana; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a): Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) was started in May, 2016 with an objective to provide access of clean cooking fuel to poor households across the country. Under PMUY, deposit free LPG connections are provided to adult women from poor households as per defined criteria. As of 30.09.2023, 9.59 Crore PMUY connections have been released in the country including 69.26 lakh in Rajasthan. District-wise details of LPG connections released under PMUY in Rajasthan are at **Annexure**.

(b) and (c): Yes Sir. In addition to applicable DBTL subsidy to the consumers, Government started a targeted subsidy of ` 200/- per 14.2 kg cylinder for up to 12 refills per annum (and proportionately pro-rated for 5 Kg connections) to the PMUY consumers in May 2022. In October 2023, Government has increased targeted subsidy to ` 300 per 14.2 kg cylinder for up to 12 refills per annum (and proportionately pro-rated for 5 Kg connections).
